

HEROES WITH HANDBAGS Hood County







A big thank you goes out to Paradise Bistro & Coffee Co. on the Square in Granbury for supporting this day of giving!




COMMUNITY EVENTS




COMMUNITY EVENTS



If a child is in immediate danger call **911.**

HOW TO VOLUNTEER

Our volunteers provide a variety of support for our agency including staffing our agency information booth at health fairs, assisting with Child Abuse Prevention Month activities, and helping with fundraisers such as Heroes with Handbags. Events can be during the week, after hours, or on weekend depending on the specific activity. Interested individuals must submit a completed Volunteer Application Packet and agree to and pass a criminal background check.
